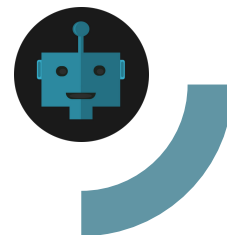

Keynote by Dr. Christopher Harris

Dr. Christopher Harris is the Director of the School Library System for the Genesee Valley BOCES, an educational services agency supporting the libraries of 22 small, rural districts in Western NY. In 2022, Dr. Harris was named a Senior Fellow for the American Library Association for school libraries and youth policy issues and in 2023 he was elected as a trustee on his local public library board.
