**Morning session:** Overview of all products with an emphasis on the popular Reading A-Z/Raz Plus.

**Afternoon session:** Science A-Z featuring interactive science lessons, high-interest books with STEM challenges and assessments, project-based learning packs, Science in the News, investigation packs, Career Files, debates, and science videos. Primary and intermediate grades.

Collaboration between classroom teachers and librarians provide students with extension activities and research support.
