- 1. Teachers will understand how to interpret their DNA reports.
- 2. Teachers will understand the basis and the role of probability in the interpretation of DNA results.
- 3. Teachers will create, compare, and analyze data sets based on the group profiles.
- 4. Teachers will verify one of the traits found in the trait report using DNA biotechnology in the wet lab.
- 5. Teachers will discuss and plan for classroom implementation.
